Format: The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Qualifying spots will be posted as denoted above. Successful qualifiers and alternates will receive more information pertaining to the 111th Texas Amateur from the TGA via email after the qualifying.

Approximate Yardage: The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,864 yards (Gold Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 111th Texas Amateur.

Qualifying Registration: There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive to their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior their starting time to receive additional information and paperwork from the starter.

Clubhouse/Golf Shop Policies: Clubhouse/golf shop is limited to six (6) people at a time. Keep mind of social distancing and follow recommended guidelines. Masks are required.

COVID-19/Masks: Masks are required when entering and remaining inside clubhouse facilities. **Masks are also required when riding in a golf cart with another player.** See [TGA Championship COVID-19 Guidelines](#) for complete details.

Practice Round Information: Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Practice rounds are subject to availability. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

Availability: Can be made two weeks ahead of qualifying date (June 29 – July 12); Anytime Monday – Thursday, after 9:30 am Friday – Sunday (club is closed on Tuesday).

Rate: \$40.00 (including cart)

COVID-19 Questionnaire: All players and caddies are responsible for completing and signing the linked questionnaire to the pairings email. **Players will not be allowed to compete in the qualifying if they do not have a signed questionnaire at their starting time.** The questionnaire will also be available to complete on the first tee.

Policies & Procedures

Transportation: Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are not included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Players must check-in with the golf shop to rent a cart. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. **Players will be assigned a specific cart and only club golf carts will be allowed (no private carts will be allowed). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names.** See [TGA Championship COVID-19 Guidelines](#) for complete details.

- Players electing to ride are responsible for paying the golf shop the qualifying round cart fee.

Qualifying Round Cart Fee: \$20.00

Caddies: Caddies are permitted but must walk at all times. See [TGA Championship COVID-19 Guidelines](#) for complete details.

Transferring Qualifying Sites: After the close of registration transferring qualifying site is not permitted.

Withdraw from Qualifying: Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Manager, [Justin Guthrie](#), ahead of their scheduled qualifying. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifying date will not be eligible for a refund.

Score Posting: At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
