NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations and clarifications, 2019 Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on UT Golf Club scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are **NOT** in effect for this event. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

- 1. **FORMAT:** The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play competition.
- 2. CADDIES: Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- 3. <u>TEES:</u> The Boys 15-18 division will play from the **Black Hannon** markers. The Boys 14 & Under division will play from the **White** Hannon markers. The Girls 12-18 division will play from the **Green Hannon** markers.
- 4. <u>AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:</u> Players must walk at all times during play of any hole, and must not use or accept automotive transportation unless acting under the direction of an LJT Referee. Push/Pull carts are permitted. Players may accept rides between the play of any two holes and from #6 Tee to #6 fairway.
- 5. **PROCEDURE FOR TIES:** In the event of a tie for the overall champion, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted, until a winner is declared. The playoff will occur immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for tournament awards will be decided by a scorecard playoff.
- 6. **SCORING:** Scores will be verified at the designated LJT scoring area behind the 18th green.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the items listed on the Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is defined by:
 - Inside edge of all paved roadways and parking lots
 - Perimeter fencing around the golf course

Note: A ball which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is deemed to be out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

- 2. <u>INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE:</u> Rock walls supporting teeing grounds and greens, rock walls below cast iron fencing defining property lines, and other rock formations are deemed to be integral parts of the golf course, from which free relief will not be granted.
- 3. MODEL LOCAL RULES: Model Local Rules, E-12 (Back on the line relief) and G-9 (Replacement of Damaged Clubs) are in effect for the event.
- 4. <u>FLAGSTICKS:</u> Flagsticks may not be touched or removed. Violations or intentional disregard will be considered a breach of the LJT Code of Conduct. For more, information, see the <u>Covid-19 Championship Guidelines</u>.
- 5. <u>BUNKERS:</u> Bunkers will be in play, and players should make their best effort to smooth the sand after playing from it. Players may take optional relief in a bunker under Model Local Rule E3 Preferred Lies. Players may mark, lift clean and place a ball within one club-length of the original spot, but MUST remain in the bunker.
- 6. **OBSTRUCTIONS:** Relief without penalty is available for the following under Rule 16.1b.
 - Flower beds and landscaped areas completely encircled by an obstruction are considered part of the same obstruction.
 - i. The brick wall behind No. 9 green is deemed an obstruction.
 - Stone walkways and gravel runoff from obstructions are considered part of the same obstruction.
- 7. <u>DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE:</u> A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty under Rule 20.1c(3). The player must decide to play two balls before making a stroke and the player should choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball. The player MUST report the facts to the committee before returning the scorecard or is subject to disqualification.
- 8. PACE OF PLAY: The established Pace of Play for UT Golf Club is 4:50 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. Please see player package and reverse side of scorecard for LJT Pace of Play Guidelines.
