NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations and clarifications, 2020 Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on Eagle Pointe Golf Club scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are **NOT** in effect for this event. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

- 1. **FORMAT:** The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play competition.
- 2. <u>CADDIES:</u> Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- 3. <u>TEES:</u> The Boys 15-18 division will play from the **BLUE LIT** tee markers. The Boys 14 & Under division will play from the **WHITE LIT** tee markers. The Girls 12-18 division will play from the **RED LIT** tee markers.
- 4. <u>AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION</u>: Players must walk at all times during play of any hole, and must not use or accept automotive transportation unless acting under the direction of an LJT Referee. Push/Pull carts are permitted. Players may accept rides in a golf cart in between play of any two holes.
- 5. <u>SCORING:</u> Scores will be verified after completing your round at the designated LJT scoring area next to the clubhouse.
- 6. <u>PROCEDURE FOR TIES</u>: In the event of a tie for the overall champion, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted, until a winner is declared. The playoff will occur immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for awards and LJT Player of the Year points will be split.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 7. <u>Out of Bounds:</u> In addition to the items listed on the 2020 Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is the inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of:
 - The inside edge/curbing, golf course side, of paved roadways (behind Hole # 17 green and Hole # 18 Tee);
 - The inside edge of the cart path near the practice putting green and the inside edge of the sidewalk of the clubhouse;
 - Parking lots/driveways (situated to the right of Hole # 18); and
 - Fence to the left of Hole # 8.

Note: A ball that crosses a roadway defined as a boundary and comes to rest beyond that boundary is deemed to be out of bounds even if it lies on another part of the course.

- 8. <u>Railroad Tie Walls:</u> As noted on the LJT Hard Card, artificial walls and pilings when used to define the margins of bunkers (Hole # 3) are integral parts of the course and are through the green.
- 9. Artificially Surfaced Pathways: Gravel and stones pathways are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Relief without penalty is available under Rule 16.1. Gravel pathways tying into cart paths are deemed to be part of the same obstruction
- Bricks Adjacent to Mulched Areas: For areas where there are bricks that border mulched ground cover, the bricks are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Free relief from the immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1 for stance, lie of ball and/ or area of intended swing.
- 11. MODEL LOCAL RULES: Model Local Rules, E-12 (Back on the line relief) & G-9 (Replacement of Damaged Clubs), F-23 (Temporary Immovable Obstructions) are in effect for the Texas Junior Golf Alliance Invitational.
- 12. <u>Doubt as to Procedure</u>: If a competitor is in doubt as to a procedure under the rules and a referee is not proximately available, to avoid delay he may play a second ball under Rule 20.1c (3). The player **must** report the facts to the Committee before returning his scorecard, otherwise he is subject to **disqualification**.
- 13. <u>Pace of Play:</u> The established Pace of Play for Eagle Pointe Golf Club is 4:29 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is available on the first tee.
