Dallas Athletic Club's Blue Course | Dallas, TX January 16-17, 2021



NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations and clarifications, 2020 Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on Dallas Athletic Club scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are **NOT** in effect for this event. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

- 1. FORMAT: The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play competition.
- 2. <u>CADDIES:</u> Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- 3. TEES: The Boys 15-18 division will play from the BLUE LIT tee markers. The Boys 14 & Under division will play from the WHITE LIT tee markers. The Girls 12-18 division will play from the RED LIT tee markers.
- **4.** <u>AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:</u> Players must walk at all times during play of any hole, and must not use or accept automotive transportation unless acting under the direction of an LIT Referee. Push/Pull carts are permitted.
- 5. SCORING: Players will attest scores in the LIT scoring area next to the clubhouse immediately following their round.
- 6. PROCEDURE FOR TIES: In the event of a tie for the overall champion, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted, until a winner is declared. The playoff will occur immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for awards and LIT Player of the Year points will be split.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 1. Out of Bounds: In addition to the items listed on the 2020 Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is the inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of:
 - a) White stakes and lines
 - b) Fence posts
 - c) Paved roads and parking lots
 - d) Netting of Driving Range to the right of No. 18

Note: A ball that crosses a roadway defined as a boundary and comes to rest beyond that boundary is deemed to be out of bounds even if it lies on another part of the course.

- 2. <u>DROPPING ZONES FOR PENALTY AREAS #4, #5, #7, #9, #11 & #16:</u> As an additional option in a yellow penalty area, a player may drop a ball in the designated dropping zone marked "LJTDZ" for the holes listed.
- 3. <u>DROPPING ZONE FOR UNPLAYABLE BALL #4:</u> As an additional option for an Unplayable Ball behind No. 4 green, a player may drop a ball in the designated dropping zone marked "LJTDZ" for one penalty stroke.
- **4.** <u>INTEGRAL OBJECTS:</u> In addition to those items listed on the LJT hard Card, the following areas are deemed integral objects from which relief will not be granted:
 - a) Metal pillars supporting Driving Range netting to the right of No. 18
 - b) Perimeter stone/rock columns adjacent to and/or attached to perimeter fence posts
- 5. EDGING GROOVE AROUND PUTTING GREEN: If a player's ball comes to rest in the narrow groove/trench made as a green collar edge, the player may obtain free relief under Rule 16.1 for the lie of the ball only. When proceeding under this option the player must lift the ball and place it, without penalty, at the nearest point of relief that is not in a penalty area or nearer the hole. Relief may be off the putting green.
- **6.** MODEL LOCAL RULES: Model Local Rule D-7 (Limiting when stroke made from putting green must be replayed) is in effect for the Winter Classic.
- 7. <u>Doubt as to Procedure:</u> If a competitor is in doubt as to a procedure under the rules and a referee is not proximately available, to avoid delay he may play a second ball under Rule 20.1c (3). The player **must** report the facts to the Committee before returning his scorecard, otherwise he is subject to **disqualification**.
- **8.** Pace of Play: The established Pace of Play for Dallas Athletic Club's Blue Course is 4:30 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard and the LJT Pace of Play Guidelines are listed on the reverse side of the scorecard.
