NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations, 2019 United States Golf Association Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on the Cedar Creek GC Trace scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are **not** in effect for this championship. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty. **The USGA hard card is on the opposite site of this Notice. Please look over the model local rules that are listed on the hard card. A copy of the model local rules is available at the Starter's table at the 1st tee.**

1. **Competition:** One 18 hole round, stroke play.
2. **Time of Starting:** See Rule 5.3a. Please report to your starting tee 10 minutes early.
3. **Tees:** Play will be from the white rectangular USGA tee markers.
4. **Scoring Tent:** Located near the practice putting green by the clubhouse. Scorecards must be returned to the scorer's tent immediately after the completion of a round.
5. **Close of Competition:** The competition shall be deemed closed when the results have been approved by the Committee and announced. See 2019 USGA hard card.
6. **Automotive Transportation:** Model local Rule G-6 is in effect. During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the Committee. A player who will play, or has played under penalty of stroke and distance is always authorized to ride on motorized transportation. Only rules officials and service personnel may use golf carts. Spectators may **NOT** use golf carts.
7. **Playoffs:** Ties for the last qualifying spot and alternates shall be broken by a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff. There will be no playoff for medalist. Duplicate medals will be awarded. The playoff will begin immediately after all scores have been approved and posted by the Official in Charge.
8. **Rules Referees and Volunteers:** Al Allen, Rich Dixon, Alan Gnospelius, Marty Javors, Read Langhenry, Mike Lonergan, Mack Seeton, Steve Suhey. Referees' golf carts are marked with a RULES sign and a small orange flag.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

1. **Out of Bounds:** In addition to the items listed on the USGA Hard Card, Out of Bounds is defined by the nearest inside points, at ground level, of (1) white stakes, (2) fences, (3) course side edges of roads, (4) white dots at the entrance/exit of road tunnels.
2. **Obstructions:** Movable Obstructions: Stakes defining penalty areas. OB stakes are not movable obstructions. Immovable Obstructions: Artificial structures and surfaced paths are immovable obstructions. See 2019 USGA hard card.
3. **Ground Under Repair (GUR):** See 2019 USGA hard card. See Rule 13.1c for repairing damage on the putting green. Areas whose perimeter are indicated by white dots on the putting greens are GUR. Relief without penalty according to Rule 16.1d. Unmarked cart wear immediately adjacent to, and within 1 club length of, cart paths, is deemed to be part of the cart path for relief purposes. Relief without penalty: nearest point of relief + one club length relief area according to Rule 14.3.
4. **Damage to Golf Clubs:** Model Local Rule G-9. Rule 4.1b(3) is modified in this way: If a player's club is "broken or significantly damaged" during the round by the player or caddie, except in cases of abuse, the player may replace the club with any club under Rule 4.1b(4).
5. **Distance Measuring Devices:** Rule 4.3a(1) allows the use of measuring devices for distance, but not slope.
6. **Doubt as to Procedure:** A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls under Rule 20.1c(3). You must **announce** to your marker or fellow competitor your intention to play a second ball and **select** the ball you wish to count in your score should the rules allow the procedure.
7. **Pace of Play:** The established Pace of Play for the River Crossing GC is 4:42 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. Please see the separate memorandum for USGA Pace of Play Guidelines.
8. **Phone Numbers for Rules Referees:** If a referee is not immediately available within sight, you may call the following numbers to request a Rules referee. Also, you may play a second ball according to item 6 above.
