## **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and USGA, it's Interpretations and Clarifications, and Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Conditions of Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All local rules listed on Lantana Golf Club's scorecards, posted on notice boards or posted on the course are **not** in effect for this tournament. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is two strokes.

- 1. Tees: Boys Division will play from the BLUE LIT tee markers. Girls Division will play from the RED LIT tee markers.
- 2. <u>Automotive Transportation:</u> Players must walk at all times during play of a hole. Players may accept cart rides in-between the play of any two holes. Non-motorized/push carts will be permitted.
- **3.** <u>Caddies:</u> Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- **4.** Format: The competition is scheduled for 54 holes of stroke-play.
- **5.** <u>Procedure for Ties:</u> In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for tournament awards will be decided by a scorecard playoff.

## SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 1. Out of Bounds: In addition to the items listed on the 2021 Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is defined by:
  - Inside edge at ground level of property fences;
  - Inside edge at ground level of white stakes;
  - White paint dots, near the base of vertical wall of tunnels, connecting across the tunnel opening; or
  - Inside edge (golf course side) of public roadways, driveways, parking lots, and associated curbing.

**Note:** A ball that comes to rest beyond the inside edge of public roadways, driveways, and parking lots is deemed to be out of bounds, even if it lies on another part of the golf course.

- 2. <u>Immovable Obstructions</u>: Inlaid or decorative stones, water stations, restrooms, ball washers, and trash receptacles adjacent to cart path are deemed to be part of the same obstruction.
- 3. <u>Integral Objects:</u> Any object listed on the LJT Hard Card, as well as all retaining walls under or next to property fences are deemed to be integral objects. Free relief is not available.
- 4. <u>Drop Zone Hole #15</u>: If, during the play of Hole # 15, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Yellow Penalty Area, the player may: Proceed under Rule 17.1d (Penalty Area Relief), or as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the designated Dropping Zone marked with the LJT Dropping Zone.
  - a. #15 Drop Zone: Approximately 75 yards
- 5. <u>Practice Areas:</u> The practice putting greens near #1 tee and behind #18 green are deemed to be Wrong Greens from which relief is MANDATORY under Rule 13.1f. The practice bunkers near #1 tee are treated as Ground Under Repair, from which relief is available under Rule 16.1.
- 6. Abnormal Course Condition: The following areas are deemed abnormal course conditions with free relief available under Rule 16.1.
  - Areas of removed sod/turf to the left of #9 fairway.
  - Exposed liners in bunkers that are attached and interfere with lie, stance or swing. Relief area must stay within the bunker.
- 7. <u>Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs):</u> Includes scoreboards, tents, championship tee signs, port-a-lets, tarps and all rebar located next to putting greens, and any other structure installed specifically for this tournament.

**Relief on Either Side:** In effect and includes any temporary immovable obstruction installed for the championship. As an additional option and in accordance with the TIO Rule for interference or intervention, a player entitled to relief may drop the ball on either side of the TIO along the arc without penalty for all TIOs.

- 8. <u>Doubt as to Procedure:</u> If a player is in doubt as to a procedure under the rules and a referee is not proximately available, to avoid delay he may play a second ball under Rule 20.1c(3). The player **must** report the facts to the Committee before returning their scorecard; otherwise the player is subject to **disqualification**.
- 9. Pace of Play: Play should be played at a prompt pace under Rule 5.6b. The established Pace of Play for Lantana Golf Club is 4:40 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. Please see the reverse side of scorecard for LJT Pace of Play Guidelines.
