NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and USGA, it's Interpretations and Clarifications, and Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Conditions of Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All local rules listed on The Club at Falcon Point's scorecards, posted on notice boards or posted on the course are **not** in effect for this tournament. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is two strokes.

- **1.** <u>Tees:</u> Boys 15-18 Division and Boys 14 & Under Division will play from the BLUE LJT tee markers. Girls 12-18 Division will play from the RED LJT tee markers.
- 2. <u>Automotive Transportation:</u> Players must walk at all times all stipulated rounds of the championship. Non-motorized/push carts will be permitted. Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- **3.** Format: The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play.
- **4.** <u>Procedure for Ties:</u> In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for tournament awards will be decided by a scorecard playoff.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 1. Out of Bounds: In addition to the items listed on the 2021 Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is defined by:
 - The inside edge at ground level of white stakes (even when located near perimeter fencing);
 - The inside edge of white lines;
 - The inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of paved roadways and parking lots;
 - The inside edge (golf course side) of sidewalk behind #5 green. White dots only identify, they do not define.
 - Perimeter fencing of the maintenance area adjacent to #9 tee (far end of the driving range);
 - The inside edge at ground level of Black Perimeter metal fencing surrounding the golf course property.

Note: A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the golf course.

- 2. Obstructions: The following are deemed to be obstructions for which relief is available without penalty under Rule 16.1:
 - Stones adjacent to paths;
 - Crushed granite paths;
 - Sanded maintenance path behind #14 tee, #15 green;
 - Concrete steps leading to teeing grounds;
 - On-course restrooms adjacent to paths.
- 3. <u>Integral Objects of the Course:</u> Brick columns connected to black perimeter fencing defining out of bounds are deemed an integral object of the course with relief not available.
- **4.** Putting Green Edging Surrounding Putting Greens: If a ball is in or on an edging groove around the putting green, or if the groove interferes with the area of the player's intended swing, the ball may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and placed in the nearest position to where it lay that is not nearer the hole and avoids interference by the condition, whether on or off the putting green.
- 5. <u>Turf Nursery:</u> The turf nursery located in front of #12 tee is deemed to be Ground Under Repair. Relief without penalty under Rule 16.1b is mandatory.
- 6. Shared Green No. 2 and No. 4: The green for hole No. 2 and hole No. 4 is split by three white dots in the center. For the play of hole No. 2, right of the white dots is a WRONG GREEN and for the play of hole No. 4 left of the white dots is a WRONG GREEN for which relief is mandatory under Rule 13.1f.
- 7. Ground Under Repair: The following areas are deemed to be Ground Under Repair. Relief without penalty under Rule 16.1 is mandatory:
 - All flower beds on the course.
 - Area left of #14 fairway.
- 8. <u>Doubt as to Procedure:</u> If a player is in doubt as to a procedure under the rules and a referee is not proximately available, to avoid delay he may play a second ball under Rule 20.1c(3). The player **must** report the facts to the Committee before returning their scorecard; otherwise the player is subject to **disqualification**.
- **9.** Pace of Play: Play should be played at a prompt pace under Rule 5.6b. The established Pace of Play for The Club at Falcon Point is 4:38 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. Please see the reverse side of scorecard for LJT Pace of Play Guidelines.
