NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations, 2021 United States Golf Association Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on Blackhorse scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are <u>NOT</u> in effect for this qualifying. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

- 1. Format: 18 holes of stroke play qualifying. Players are competing for four (4) qualifying spots and two (2) alternate positions.
- 2. <u>Tees:</u> All play will be contested from the white rectangular USGA tee markers.
- 3. Automotive Transportation: Players MUST walk at all times during the qualifying round. SPECTATOR CARTS ARE NOT ALLOWED
- 4. <u>Procedures for Ties:</u> Should there be a tie for the last qualifying spot and/or alternate position, the tie will be broken by a sudden death playoff after all scores have been officially approved and posted. The playoff will begin immediately after all scores have been approved and posted. There will be no playoff for qualifying medalist.
- 5. <u>Scoring</u>: Scorecards must be attested and returned immediately after completing your round to the designated USGA scoring area, which is located in front of the halfway house. The scoring area is defined as within the roped area surrounding the tent. The scorecard is considered returned when the player has left the designated scoring area.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 6. <u>Out of Bounds</u>: Defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, When white stakes are in front of fence posts, the white stakes define Out of Bounds.
- 7. <u>Dropping Zone Hole #17:</u> If, during play of hole #17, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the Penalty Area on hole #17, the player may:
 - Proceed under Rule 17.1d; or
 - as an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the designated Dropping Zone (marked "DZ"):
 - Hole #17 Forward most teeing area approximately125 yards
- 8. Immovable Obstructions: Include, but are not limited to:
 - All artificially surfaced paths, including any adjacent curbing or rocks; and
 - All restrooms and shelters;

Immovable Obstructions Adjacent to, Within or Abutting Each Other, such as artificially surfaced paths, curbing, drains, permanent structures, etc., are considered a single obstruction.

- 9. <u>Temporary Immovable Obstructions</u>: Tents, signage and other temporary structures installed specifically for this qualifying are considered Temporary Immovable Obstructions from which relief is available. See Model Local Rule F-23 and F-23 E(2).
- **10.** <u>Doubts as to Procedure:</u> A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls under Rule 20.1c(3).
- 11. <u>Pace of Play:</u> Play should be played at a prompt pace under Rule 5.6b. The established Pace of Play for Blackhorse south is <u>4:51</u> for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. See separate memorandum for the USGA Pace of Play Policy.
- **12.** Penalty Area Hole 16: The outside edge of cart path curbing on hole 16 defines the edge of the penalty. Red stakes identify the penalty area.
