NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and USGA, its Interpretations and Clarifications, and Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Conditions of Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All local rules listed on The Clubs of Kingwood's (Lake Course) scorecards, posted on notice boards or posted on the course are **not** in effect for this tournament. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is two strokes.

1. **Tees:** Boys 14 & Under Division will play from the BLUE LJT tee markers. Girls 15-18 Division will play from the WHITE LJT tee markers. Girls 14 & Under will play from the RED LJT tee markers.
2. **Automotive Transportation:** Players must walk at all times during play of a hole. Players may accept cart rides in-between the play of any two holes. Non-motorized/push carts will be permitted.
3. **Caddies:** Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
4. **Scoring:** Scores must be attested and verified verbally immediately after completing the round to the designated LJT scoring area, which is located behind the #9 & #18 green. The scorecard is considered returned when the player verbally approved what is online/TV.
5. **Format:** The Girls 15-18 Division is scheduled for 54 holes of stroke play competition, with the size of the field being reduced to the low 27 players and ties for the final round. The Boys and Girls 14 & Under Divisions are scheduled for 36 holes of stroke play competition.
6. **Procedure for Ties:** In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for tournament awards will be decided by a scorecard playoff.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

1. **Out of Bounds:** Out of bounds is defined by white stakes, fence posts, parking lot and roadways.
 - a. The course-side edge of all white stakes or posts at ground level;
 - b. The course-side edge of white lines right of #3 & left of #9;
 - c. The course-side edge of property fence posts and concrete walls;
 - d. The course-side edge of the split rail perimeter fencing behind #2 green;
 - e. The course-side edge/curbing of public roadway behind hole #14.
 - i. **Note:** If a ball crosses a roadway and comes to rest on another hole, that ball is out of bounds even though it is on the golf course.
2. **Immovable Obstructions:** Include, but are not limited to:
 - All **artificially surfaced paths**, including any adjacent curbing or rocks;
 - All irrigation and utility boxes;
 - Large black piping right of #2 Tee & Fairway;
 - Shelters and restrooms on holes #4, #7, #8 & #15;
 - Wood split rail fences that do not define out of bounds on holes #13 & #18; and
 - All drainage channels (*see item 3*).**Immovable Obstructions Adjacent to, Within or Abutting Each Other**, such as artificially surfaced paths, curbing, drains, permanent structures, etc., are considered a single obstruction.
3. **Drainage Channels:** All drainage channels that are made of artificial materials in the general area are treated as immovable obstructions. A player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b.
4. **Temporary Immovable Obstructions:** Tents, signage and other temporary structures installed specifically for this qualifying are considered Temporary Immovable Obstructions from which relief is available. See Model Local Rule F-23 and F-23 E(2).
5. **Doubts as to Procedure:** A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls under Rule 20.1c(3).
6. **Pace of Play:** Play should be played at a prompt pace under Rule 5.6b. The established Pace of Play for The Clubs of Kingwood (Lake Course) is **4:39** for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. See separate memorandum for the USGA Pace of Play Policy.
