

## 38<sup>th</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur Qualifying (Last Chance | Clubs of Kingwood)



## **Qualifying Information**

**Format:** The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers will receive more information pertaining to the 38<sup>th</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur from the TGA via email after the qualifying.

**Approximate Yardage:** The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,777 yards (Blue Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 38<sup>th</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur.

**Qualifying Registration:** There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive to their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

**Scorecards/Paperwork:** Scorecards will be utilized for Texas Mid-Amateur Qualifying. Players will receive a physical copy of scorecard, Notice to Players and Hole Locations Sheet on the starting tee.

Clubhouse/Golf Shop Policies: Keep mind of social distancing and follow all clubhouse/golf shop guidelines.

**COVID-19/Masks:** Masks are encouraged when riding in a golf cart with another player and when social distancing is not possible. See TGA Championship COVID-19 Guidelines for complete details. Players must abide by all host club guidelines.

**COVID-19 Assessment:** All players and caddies are responsible for completing and signing a COVID-19 self-assessment prior to their qualifying round. **Players will not be allowed to compete in the qualifying if they do not complete the assessment at their starting time.** The assessment will be available to complete on the players starting tee.

**Practice Round Information:** Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Practice rounds are subject to availability. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round. Practice round can be scheduled by email at <a href="mailto:kingwoodteetimes@gmail.com">kingwoodteetimes@gmail.com</a>.

Availability: Wednesday, August 25 – Tuesday, August 31. Based on club availability.

## **Policies & Procedures**

**Transportation:** Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. TGA 'One-Seat' Policy will be in effect.

**TGA 'One-Seat' Policy:** Either the player or his caddie may ride during the qualifying but not at the same time. If the player is riding, his caddie **MUST** walk. If the caddie is riding, the player **MUST** walk.

**Caddies:** Caddies are permitted and must be provided by the player.

**Withdraw from Qualifying:** Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Tournament Manager, <u>Justin Guthrie</u>, ahead of their scheduled qualifying. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifying date will not be eligible for a refund.

**Score Posting:** At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
