### NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf, the USGA Hard Card, and Supplemental Local Rules listed below.

### SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

*The USGA hard card is on the opposite side of this Notice. Please look over the model local rules that are listed on the hard card. A copy of the model local rules is available at the Starter's table at the 1<sup>st</sup> tee.*

- 1. Tees:** All competitors will compete from the **USGA** tee markers
- 2. Transportation:** Players must walk at all times unless transported by a Rules Official to return for stroke and distance replay (USGA Hard Card, Model Rule G-8).
- 3. Immovable Obstructions:** Artificially surfaced paths (consisting of crushed stone), ornamental stones and curbing located adjacent to paved cart paths are deemed to be part of the same obstruction.
- 4. Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens:** Relief from obstruction may be taken as an extra relief option under Rule 16.1 as outlined by Model Local Rule F-5. The obstruction must be on the line of play and within two club lengths of the putting green, and the ball must lie within two club lengths of the obstruction. In addition, the ball must lie in part of the general area cut to fairway height or less.
- 5. Movable Obstructions:** Unpainted wooden posts with green or red painted tips on tops are movable obstructions. Also, boundary posts for penalty areas are movable obstructions. Relief is available under Rule 15.2
- 6. Out of Bounds:** Out of bounds is defined by the course-side points of white stakes at ground level. In addition, out of bounds is defined by: (a) the inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of adjacent parking lots, roadway and driveways; (b) property fences/walls. Note: A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that is out of bounds, even if it may lie on another part of the golf course.
- 7. Model Local Rules:** Please review the Model Local Rules in effect for this tournament, which are listed on the USGA Hard Card on the opposite side of this page. A copy of the text of the model rules is available at the first tee on the Starter's table.
