Play is governed by the 2021 Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association and R&A, its Interpretations and clarifications, 2019 Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Terms of the Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All Local Rules listed on Corpus Christi Country Club scorecards, notice boards or posted on the course are **NOT** in effect for this event. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule is the general penalty.

- 1. **FORMAT:** The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play competition.
- 2. CADDIES: Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
- 3. <u>TEES:</u> The Boys 15-18 division will play from the **BLUE LIT** tee markers. The Boys 14 & Under division will play from the **WHITE** LIT tee markers. The Girls 12-18 division will play from the **RED LIT** tee markers.
- 4. <u>AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:</u> Players must walk at all times during play of any hole, and must not use or accept automotive transportation unless acting under the direction of an LJT Referee. Push/Pull carts are permitted. Players may accept rides in a golf cart in between play of any two holes.
- 5. <u>SCORING:</u> Players will attest scores in the scoring tent between 9 and 18 greens. Once players leave the scoring area, they will be submitted and final.
- 6. **PROCEDURE FOR TIES:** In the event of a tie for the overall champion, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted, until a winner is declared. The playoff will occur immediately after all scores have been verified. All ties for awards will be broken using the Rules of Golf Scorecard method. Ties for Player of the Year Standings will be split.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the items listed on the Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of bounds is defined by:
 - a. The inside edge (golf course side) of all paved roadways;
 - b. White wooden posts defining the boundary of the golf course;
 - c. Perimeter fencing at edge of golf course.

Note: When both a fence and white post are present, the post defines the out of bounds.

Note: A ball which crosses a road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is deemed to be out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

- 2. <u>DESIGNATED PRACTICE AREAS:</u> The practice areas located near No. 9 green are deemed to be Wrong Greens, from which relief is mandatory under Rule 13.1f.
- **3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** The following areas are deemed to be Ground Under Repair from which relief is available under Rule 16.1.
 - a. The Turf nursery in front of No. 18 tee. Relief from this area is mandatory.
 - b. Ruts/tracks made by carts in the General Area
- **4. INTEGRAL OBJECTS:** The green posts to the left of Holes 10 and 15 are deemed to be Integral Objects. No free relief is available for interference caused by these posts.
- 5. <u>DOUBT AS TO PROCEDURE:</u> A player who is uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole may complete the hole with two balls without penalty under Rule 20.1c(3). The player must decide to play two balls before making a stroke and choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball. The player MUST report the facts to the committee before returning the scorecard or is subject to disqualification.
- **PACE OF PLAY:** The established Pace of Play for Corpus Christi Country Club is 4 hours and 30 minutes for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard and the LJT Pace of Play Guidelines are listed on the reverse side of the scorecard.
