

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the 2019 Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A and USGA, its Interpretations and Clarifications, and Legends Junior Tour Local Rules and Conditions of Competition ('Hard Card') and where applicable, the following Local Rules. All local rules listed on Riverhill Country Club's scorecards, posted on notice boards or posted on the course are **not** in effect for this tournament. Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a Local Rule or Condition is two strokes.

1. **Tees:** Boys 12-18 Division will play from the BLUE LJT tee markers. Girls 12-18 Division will play from the RED LJT tee markers.
2. **Automotive Transportation:** Players must walk at all times all stipulated rounds of the championship. Non-motorized/push carts will be permitted. Rule 10.3a is modified in this way: A player must not have a caddie during the round.
3. **Format:** The competition is scheduled for 36 holes of stroke-play.
4. **Procedure for Ties:** In the event of a tie for the championship, a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted immediately after all scores have been verified. All other ties for tournament awards will be decided by a scorecard playoff.

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES OF PLAY

1. **Out of Bounds:** In addition to the items listed on the 2021 Legends Junior Tour Hard Card, Out of Bounds is defined by:

- The inside edge at ground level of white stakes (even when located near perimeter fencing);
- The inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of paved roadways and parking lots.
- The inside edge/curbing (golf course side) of cart path behind #9 & #18 green.

***Note:** A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the golf course.*

2. **Drop Zone – Hole #11:** If, during play of hole #11, a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found lies in the yellow penalty area on **hole 11**, the player may:
 - Proceed under *Rule 17.1d*; or
 - As an additional option, drop the original ball or another ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the designated Dropping Zone identified with "LJT DZ."
 - *Hole 11 – the forward tee; approx. 90 yards to the green.*
3. **Ground Under Repair:** Ground under repair includes but is not limited to areas encircled by white lines. **Areas surrounded by green stake and rope are NOT Ground Under Repair.**
4. **Immovable Obstructions:** **Include**, but are not limited to artificially surfaced paths, decorative stones (curbing) adjacent to cart paths, and restrooms, and bunker lining. **Immovable Obstructions Adjacent to, Within or Abutting Each Other**, such as artificially surfaced paths, curbing, drains, permanent structures, etc., are considered a single obstruction.
5. **Damage on the Putting Green:** Damage on the putting green caused by a person or outside influence, such as: shoe damage, scrapes, indentations, animal tracks or hoof indentations may be repaired. See Rule 13.1 for a list of what can and cannot be repaired.
6. **Ground Under Repair on Greens #1, 3, 10, 12, 13, 14:** If a player's ball is on the putting green and there is interference by an abnormal course condition (**identified by white dots surrounding the GUR**), the player may take free relief by placing the original ball or another ball on the spot of the nearest point of complete relief, using the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b(2) and 14.2e.
 - The nearest point of complete relief must be either on the putting green or in the general area.
 - If there is no such nearest point of complete relief, the player may still take this relief by using the point of maximum available relief, which must either be on the putting green or in the general area.

***Note:** For a ball on the putting green, a player may take free relief for the following: area of intended swing, stance, lie of the ball and line of play (line of play relief only available for ball on putting green).*
7. **Turf Nursery:** The turf nursery located between #12 and #17 is a wrong putting green. Relief from the turf nursery is mandatory. Relief without penalty is mandatory under Rule 13.
8. **Doubt as to Procedure/Pace of Play:** If in doubt as to procedure and an official is not nearby, to avoid delay, players are encouraged to play a second ball in accordance with Rule 20.1c(3). The player must report the facts to a Rules Committee member before returning his scorecard. The established Pace of Play for Riverhill CC is 4:25 for 18 holes. The time to complete each hole is printed on the scorecard. Please see reverse side of scorecard for LJT Pace of Play Policy.
