

### Qualifying Information

**Date:** Monday, July 17, 2023

**Alternate Positions:** 4

**Format:** The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers and alternates will receive more information pertaining to the 40<sup>th</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur from the TGA via email after qualifying.

**Approximate Yardage:** The qualifying yardage will be approximately 7,000 (Championship Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 40<sup>th</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur.

**Qualifying Registration:** There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive to their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

**Scorecards:** Scorecards will be utilized for Texas Mid-Amateur Qualifying. Players will keep scores on their scorecard, and they will receive a GGID for live scoring on the mobile app.

**Clubhouse/Golf Shop Policies:** Keep mind of social distancing and follow all clubhouse/golf shop guidelines.

**Practice Round Information:** Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

**Availability:** Contact Club

**Rate:** \$65 (Notify them you are a Texas Mid-Amateur Qualifying participant)

### Policies & Procedures

**Transportation:** Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. **Players will be assigned a specific cart and only host club golf carts will be permitted (no private carts). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names.** See [TGA Policies and Procedures](#) for complete details.

**Caddies:** Caddies are permitted. Caddies must adhere to the TGA Code of Conduct and dress code. As a reminder, players are responsible for the actions of their caddies. See [Men's Policies and Procedures](#) for complete details.

**'One-Seat' Policy:** When riding in a golf cart, there may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time. The player can ride in or move a golf cart with another player's caddie in it, so long as the player whose caddie is in the cart is not riding in another cart at the same time. See [Men's Policies and Procedures](#) for complete details.

**Transferring Qualifying Sites:** Changing a qualifying site is permissible, only before the tournament entry deadline. Or, if a player is entered in a Texas Mid-Amateur qualifier and the entry deadline has passed and circumstances arise that would cause him to miss his assigned qualifier, he may follow the "Walk-Up Procedure", outlined in the Men's Policies & Procedures, at another qualifier. **Withdraw from Qualifying:** Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Tournament Coordinator, [Duffy Suhr](#), ahead of their scheduled qualifying. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifying date will not be eligible for a refund.

**Score Posting:** At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
