## **Qualifying Information**

**Format:** The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers and alternates will receive more information pertaining to the 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Senior Amateur from the TGA via email after qualifying.

**Approximate Yardage:** The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,500 yards (Blue Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Senior Amateur.

**Qualifying Registration:** There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive at their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior to their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

**Scorecards:** Scorecards will be utilized for Texas Senior Amateur Qualifying. Players will keep scores on their scorecard, and they will receive a GGID for live scoring on the mobile app.

Clubhouse/Golf Shop Policies: Players are to follow all clubhouse/golf shop guidelines.

**Practice Round Information:** Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

Availability: Tuesday – Thursday Anytime after 11 AM; Friday-Saturday Anytime after 12 PM Rate: \$54 (Notify them you are a Texas Senior Amateur Qualifying participant)

## Policies & Procedures

**Transportation:** Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. Players will be assigned a specific cart and only host club golf carts will be permitted (no private carts). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names. See <u>TGA Policies and</u> <u>Procedures</u> for complete details.

**Caddies:** Caddies are permitted. Caddies must adhere to the TGA Code of Conduct and dress code. As a reminder, players are responsible for the actions of their caddies. See <u>Men's Policies and Procedures</u> for complete details.

'One-Seat' Policy: When riding in a golf cart, there may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time. The player can ride in or move a golf cart with another player's caddie in it, so long as the player whose caddie is in the cart is not riding in another cart at the same time. See <u>Men's Policies and Procedures</u> for complete details.

**Transferring Qualifying Sites:** Changing a qualifying site is permissible, <u>only before</u> the tournament entry deadline. Or, if a player is entered in a Texas Senior Amateur qualifier and the entry deadline has passed and circumstances arise that would cause him to miss his assigned qualifier, he may follow the "Walk-Up Procedure", outlined in the Men's Polices & Procedures, at another qualifier. Withdraw from Qualifying: Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Tournament Coordinator, <u>Harris Milson</u>, ahead of their scheduled qualifying. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifying date will not be eligible for a refund.

**Score Posting:** At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
