

### Qualifying Information

**Date:** July 1, 2024

**Site:** The Hills Country Club (Live Oak)

**Field Size:** Max of 84

**Qualifying Spots:** TBD

**Alternate Positions:** TBD

**Format:** The qualifying is scheduled for 18 holes of individual stroke play. Successful qualifiers and alternates will receive more information pertaining to the 41<sup>st</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur from the TGA via email after the qualifier.

**Approximate Yardage:** The qualifying yardage will be approximately 6,800 (Gold Tees). Best efforts will be made at the qualifying site to replicate a course set-up appropriate to the 41<sup>st</sup> Texas Mid-Amateur.

**Qualifying Registration:** There is no official on-site registration required. It is asked that players arrive at their respective starting tee 8-10 minutes prior to their starting time to receive additional information from the starter.

**Playoff:** Ties for the last qualifying spot will be broken by a sudden death hole-by-hole playoff. There will be no playoff for the medalist. The playoff will begin immediately after all scores have been approved and posted by the Official-in-Charge.

**Practice Round Information:** Practice rounds are available at the host club in advance of the qualifying date. Practice rounds are subject to availability. Players must contact the host club directly to schedule a practice round.

**Availability:** Any day after 11:00 AM, two weeks prior to qualifying.

**Rate:** \$40.00

### Policies & Procedures

**Transportation:** Players may walk or ride at their discretion during qualifying rounds. Carts are included as part of the qualifying entry fee. Push/pull carts are permitted at TGA qualifying. **Players will be assigned a specific cart and only club golf carts will be allowed (no private carts will be allowed). Carts will be identified and assigned by a TGA Cart Sign with player names.** There may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time with two (2) carts per group.

**Caddies:** Caddies are permitted. Caddies must adhere to the TGA Code of Conduct and dress code. As a reminder, players are responsible for the actions of their caddies. See [TGA Men's Competition Policies](#) for complete details.

**'One-Seat' Policy:** When riding in a golf cart, there may not be more than two (2) riders per cart at any time. The player can ride in or move a golf cart with another player's caddie in it, so long as the player whose caddie is in the cart is not riding in another cart at the same time. **Transferring Qualifying Sites:** Changing a qualifying site is permissible, **ONLY before the tournament entry deadline of June 26 at 5:00 PM.** Or, if a player is entered in a Texas Mid-Amateur qualifier and the entry deadline has passed and circumstances arise that would cause him to miss his assigned qualifier, he may follow the "Walk Up Procedure". **Withdraw from Qualifying:** Players needing to withdraw from their respective qualifying site should contact TGA Tournament Manager, [Owen Kinney](#), or TGA Tournament Director, [Justin Guthrie](#), ahead of their scheduled qualifying. Players failing to contact the TGA prior to their qualifying date will not be eligible for a refund or the "Walk Up Procedure".

**Score Posting:** At the conclusion of qualifying, each player's score will be automatically posted by the TGA as a 'C', or Competition score, to their World Handicap System GHIN number. Please do not enter your own score from the qualifying round as this will result in a double post.
